Study Area 12th Street Connector



The Wilmington Area Planning Council (WILMAPCO) in coordination with the City of Wilmington and Delaware Department of Transportation are beginning a transportation planning study to connect 12th Street from I-495 to the Brandywine Waterfront and the 16th Street Bridge. The purpose of this study is to create a reimagined 12th Street corridor utilizing new transportation patterns that generate economic growth and provide more efficient and multi-modal connections for people to access the area. The transportation investments can also incorporate community enhancements and green infrastructure to help beautify the neighborhood and reduce flood risk.
