EXECUTIVE ORDER 2010-2
Wilmington Bicycle Advisory Committee

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington recognizes the considerable environmental, economic and public health benefits of bicycling for both recreation and transportation purposes; and

WHEREAS, in August 2008, an Executive Order was issued outlining steps the City of Wilmington is taking to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and preserve a respectable quality of life for our residents and visitors. Bicycling supports this goal by reducing air pollution, relieving traffic congestion and offering riders an opportunity to experience the City's impressive array of architecture and natural scenery; and

WHEREAS, as a result, the City of Wilmington deems it appropriate to promote bicycling as a viable transportation choice and to develop strategies to encourage the action.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JAMES M. BAKER, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, DELAWARE, DO HEREBY ORDER:

1. The Wilmington Bicycle Advisory Committee (WBAC) shall be established with the purpose of providing advice to the City Administration on matters relating to bicycling and to raise public awareness of bicycling issues.
2. All WBAC members will be appointed by the Mayor and will represent a collective partnership of government, city residents, the nonprofit community and bicycle enthusiasts.

This Executive Order shall become effective immediately.
