Action Item #11: To Endorse the 2022 Regional Progress Report

Description/Summary of Item: The 2022 Regional Progress Report tracks the progress of the actions in the 2050 Regional Transportation Plan. Each action is assigned a green, yellow, or red light to indicate good progress, partial or mixed progress, or poor progress in meeting that action. Overall, 60% of the actions received green lights, 23% yellow lights and 17% red lights.

Key areas of success include but are not limited to conforming to air quality requirements, subregional planning and implementation, congestion mitigation process, and our work in promoting active transportation.

Problem areas include but are not limited to encouraging future growth along the I-95 corridor in New Castle County, the subsequent continued growth in single occupancy vehicle trips and projected rise in vehicle miles traveled and improving safety for all road users.

<u>Summary of Action Taken by PAC:</u> The PAC did not take action, but received a presentation on the progress report and reviewed the document for public-friendliness.

<u>Summary of Action Taken by TAC:</u> The TAC recommended Council endorse the 2022 Regional Progress Report at their February 17, 2022 meeting.

<u>Summary of Action Taken by Subcommittee/Task Force (if applicable):</u> The Nonmotorized Transportation Working Group and Air Quality Subcommittee reviewed the 2022 Regional Progress Report but did not take any action.

<u>WILMAPCO Staff Recommendations:</u> The WILMAPCO staff recommends that the Council endorse the 2022 Regional Progress Report.
