Possible Improvements from Prior Studies

Garasches Lane Extended
Creates a 2-way connection between US13 and SR9 south of the railroad

Pyles Lane Extended
Contingent on property relocations this idea would create an alternate connection from SR9 to the Port Area without going through a neighborhood

Pigeon Point Road Extended
Creates an alternate connection from I-295 to the Port Area avoiding SR9
