HELP PLAN FOR DELAWARE CITY'S FUTURE

Delaware City is updating its Comprehensive Plan and developing a Transportation Plan to guide future land use and transportation decision-making and investment. Your involvement is key to identifying strategies for Delaware City's future that fulfill your community's vision, enhance your quality of life, and address your greatest needs.

The Comprehensive Plan will examine future opportunities and challenges including community design, historic preservation, open space & recreation, economic development and annexation. The process will update the Comprehensive Plan, last adopted in January 2001. Survey results, vision, goals and strategies will be presented at the public workshop.

The Transportation Plan will consider existing conditions and future needs. The plan will address roadway improvements, traffic calming, pedestrian and bicycle improvements, and demand for public transit.
