Public Workshop to highlight several transportation projects in the City of Wilmington has been announced

WILMINGTON, DE—Wilmington Initiatives, a group of partners in the City of Wilmington working to promote a balanced transportation system, is sponsoring an Open House Public Workshop about transportation projects in Wilmington on Wednesday, February 18, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., at the City/County Building lobby (800 French Street, Wilmington).

Wilmington Initiatives encourages everyone who lives, works, or plays in Wilmington to attend this workshop to learn more and to provide feedback about these projects:

### **Christina River Bridge Project**

This project proposes to construct a new crossing over the Christina River to add another access point to the Wilmington Riverfront attractions and to improve access to US 13, I-495 and I-95. Updates will include the final alignment, proposed extension of S. Madison Street, and project schedule.

### **Wilmington Bike Share Feasibility Study**
