<b>White Clay Creek Bike/Ped Bridge</b>	Newark	This project proposes a separated bike/ped bridge over White Clay Creek at Paper Mill Road. 10/4/2011
<b>Brandywine South Pedestrian and Trail Improvements</b>	Wilmington Dept. of Public Works	This project is located in the City of Wilmington, on the south side of Brandywine Creek in the vicinity of Water Division's raceway. Scope of work includes: improvements near the N. Van Buren St. Bridge, pedestrian and trail accommodations for various raceway crossings, and linking various sidewalk facilities. 2/13/2012
<b>St. Georges Streetscape Phase III</b>	St. Georges Civic Association	This project is a continuation of Phase I and Phase II within the St.Georges area. The project is Phase III which will provide streetscape enhancements along Broad Street. 2/20/2012
<b>Concord Avenue Streetscape Improvements Phase II</b>	Wilmington	This project proposes streetscape improvements along 500, 600, and 700 blocks of Concord Ave in the City of Wilmington specifically between Baynard Boulevard and Madison Street. This project was initiated by the <b>Second District Neighborhood Planning Council</b> . 5/10/2012
<b>Old Brandywine Village Streetscape Improvements</b>	Wilmington	This project is located in the City of Wilmington, on Concord Avenue from Madison Street to Market Street; across Market Street and continuing down Vandever Ave. to Jessup Avenue, right on Jessup Avenue to the 16th St./Jessup Street bridge. This project was initiated by <b>Old Brandywine Village, Inc.</b> 8/16/2012
<b>City of Wilmington Pedestrian Safety Improvements</b>	Wilmington Dept. of Public Works	This project is located in the City of Wilmington in the downtown area. Scope of work includes: bulb-outs, curb ramps, crosswalks, pedestrian signals, and lighting. 2/19/2013
<b>Town of Townsend Streetscape Improvements Phase II</b>	Town of Townsend	This Project is located in the Town of Townsend, on Main St. from Edgar Rd. to Chestnut St. Scope of work includes: Replacing or installing sidewalk, curb, curb ramps, lighting, and asphalt mill and overlay. 6/10/2014
<b>Auburn Valley Trail Facility</b>	DNREC	This project involves the construction of a two-mile shared use trail connecting revitalized Yorklyn Village with Hockessin Village. The new trail would be made up of a mixture of on-alignment and off-alignment improvements along Yorklyn Road from Yorklyn Village south to Old Wilmington Road. 9/30/2014

<b>SR 9 and Memorial Drive Corridor Pedestrian Improvements</b>	New Castle County	Planning, design and construction of pedestrian safety and access improvements to various intersections and roadway segments within New Castle County's Route 9 Innovation District located generally along the SR 9 and Memorial Driver corridors north of I-295.
<b>Newark Main Street Parklets and Crosswalk Upgrades</b>	Newark	Design and construction of new and expanded bumpouts at several crosswalk Main Street locations with bicycle parking and pedestrian seating.
<b>Delaware and Pennsylvania Avenues</b>	Wilmington	Complete Streets project on Delaware and Pennsylvania Avenues and portions of West 10 <sup>th</sup> , 11 <sup>th</sup> and 12 <sup>th</sup> Streets between North Washington and North Harrison Streets.
<b>North and South Union Streets</b>	Wilmington / West Side Grows Together	Road Diet on Union Street from Pennsylvania Ave south to the Wilmington city line. Space gained from this redesign will allow for wider sidewalks, back-in angled parking, streetscape enhancements and a bike lane.
<b>West 4<sup>th</sup> and North Rodney Streets</b>	Wilmington	Complete Streets project at the intersection of West 4 <sup>th</sup> and North Rodney Streets.
<b>North King Street and H. Fletcher Brown Park</b>	Wilmington / Wilm. Rotary Club	Renovate pedestrian access to H. Fletcher Brown Park and revert North King Street back to its historic two-way pattern of traffic.
<b>North Church and Spruce Streets</b>	Wilmington / Wilm. Housing Partnership	Complete Streets project in the vicinity of North Spruce and Church Streets to provide access to transit, pedestrian/bicycle improvements, and street lighting enhancements.
