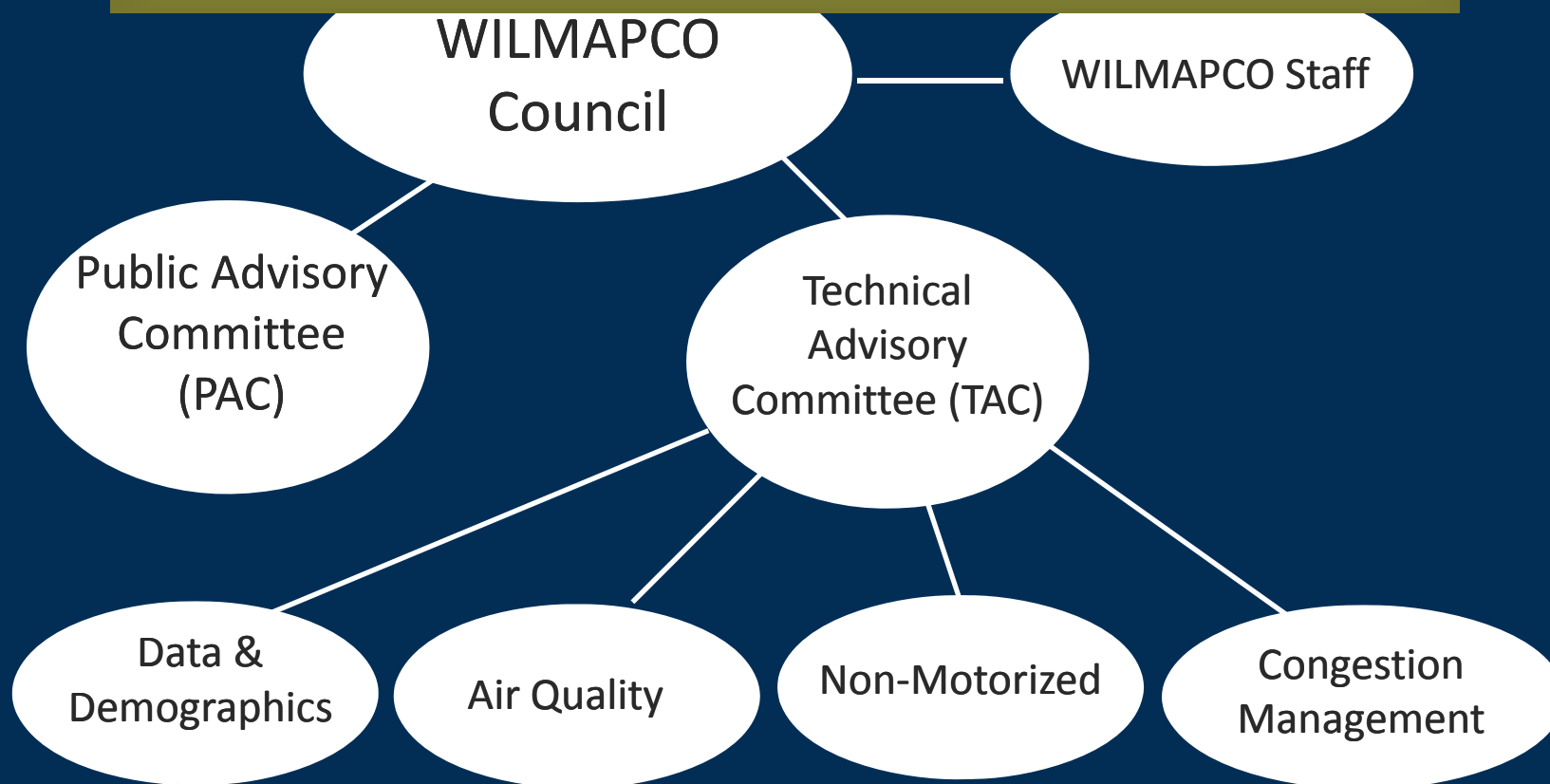

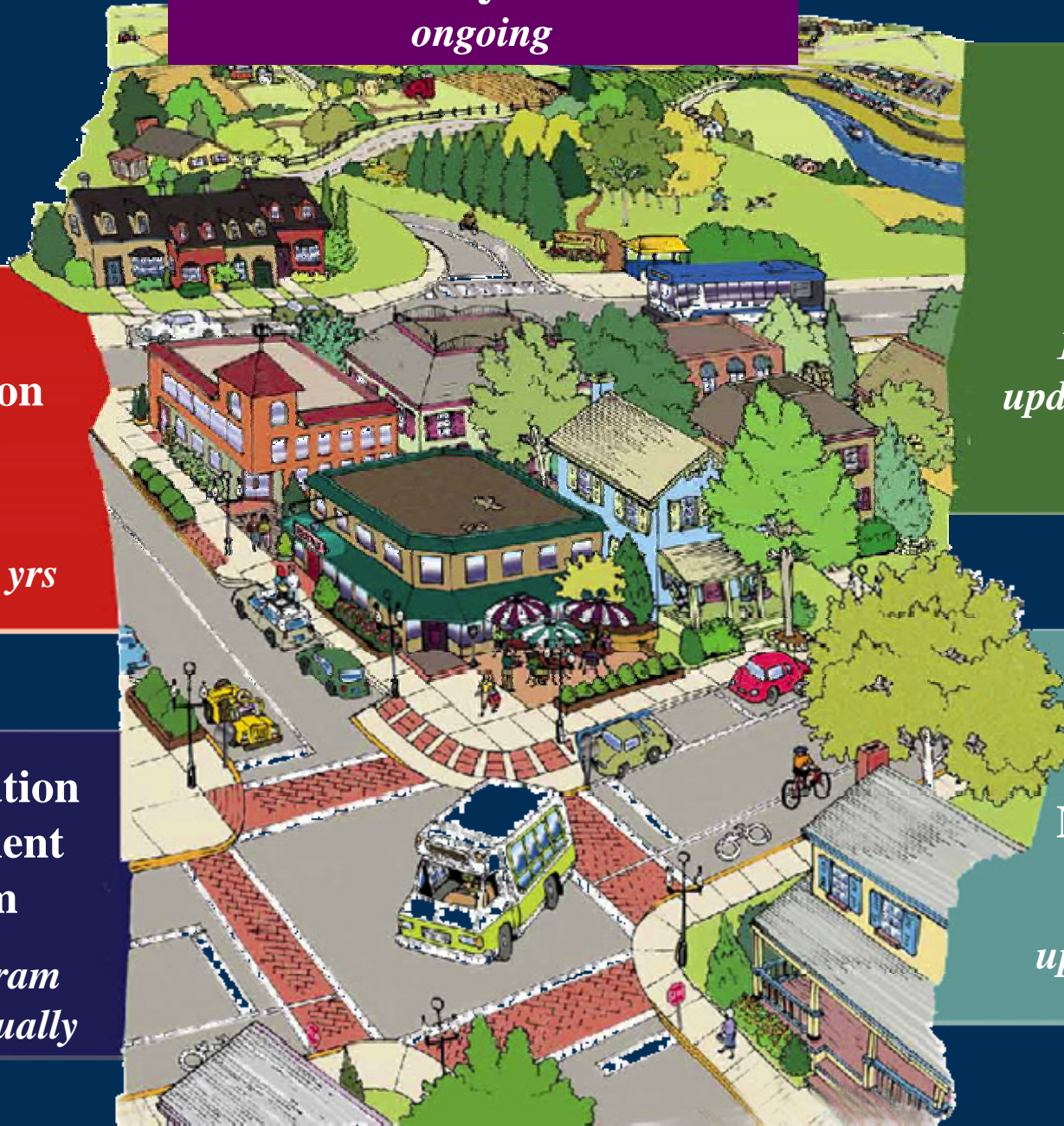

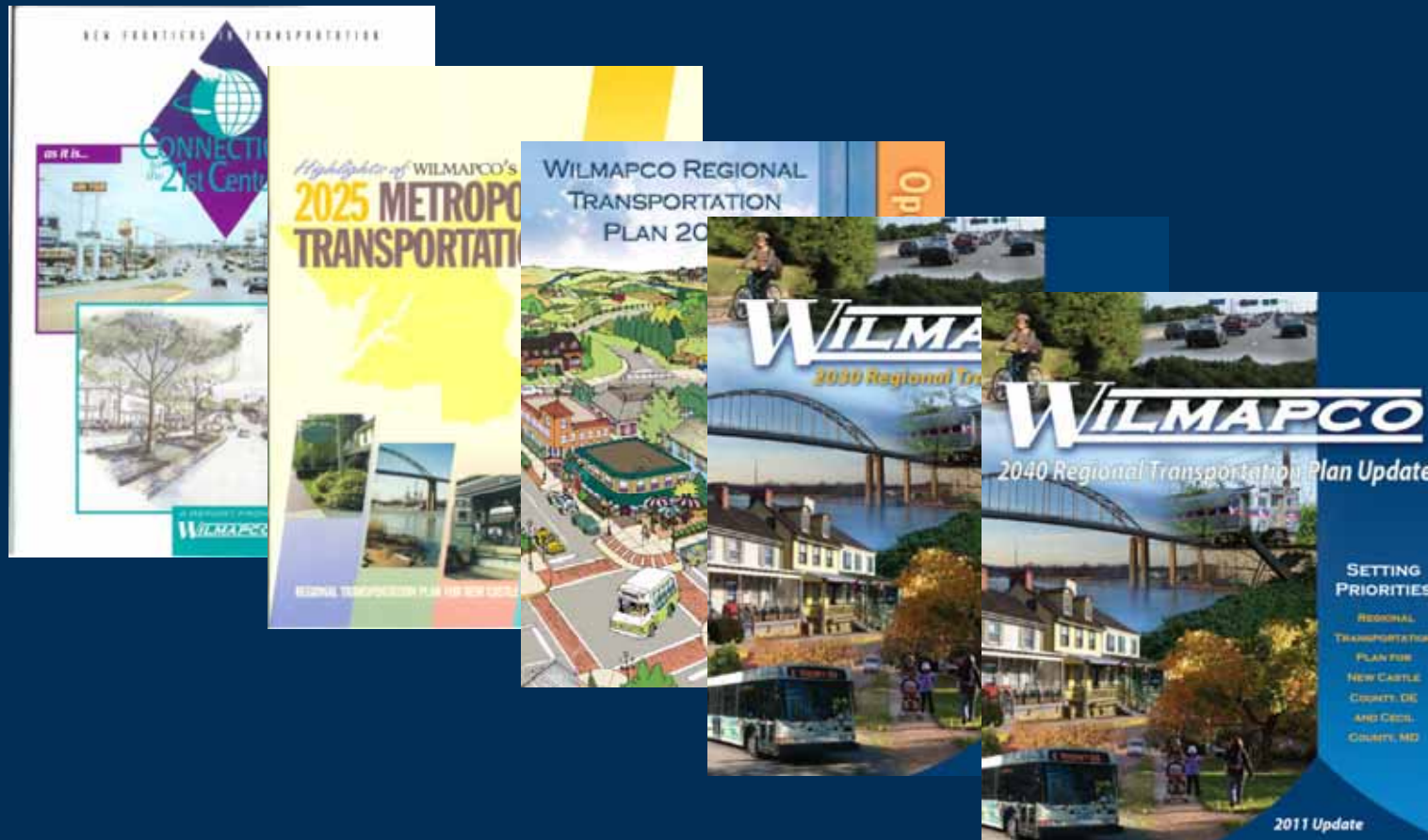

- Complete prior to March 2015

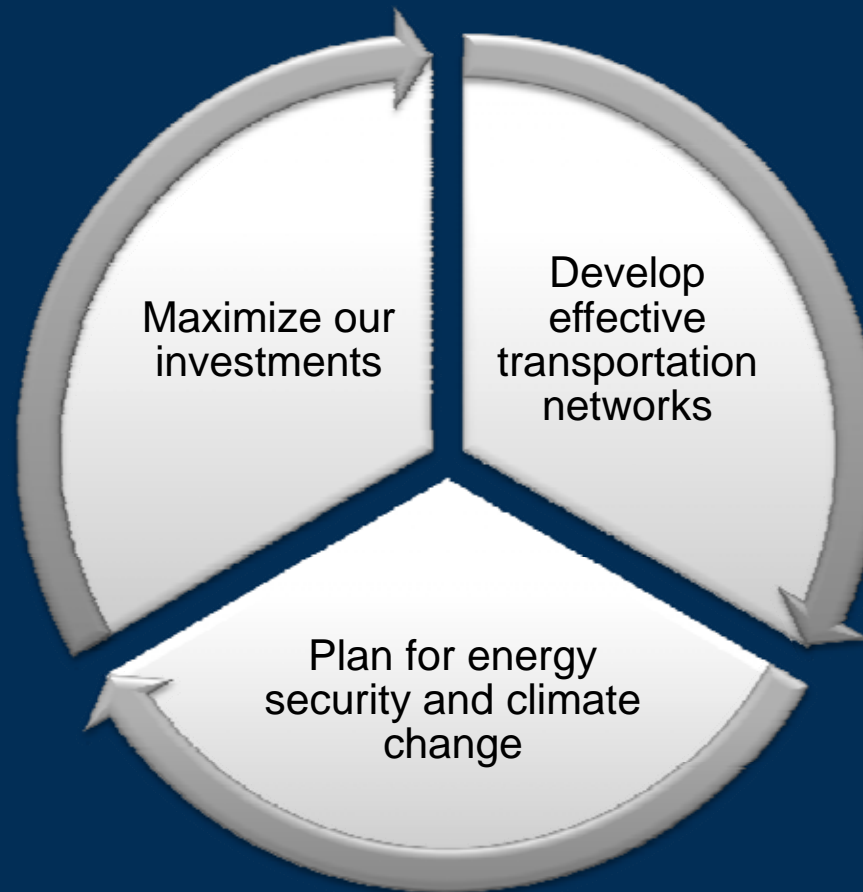

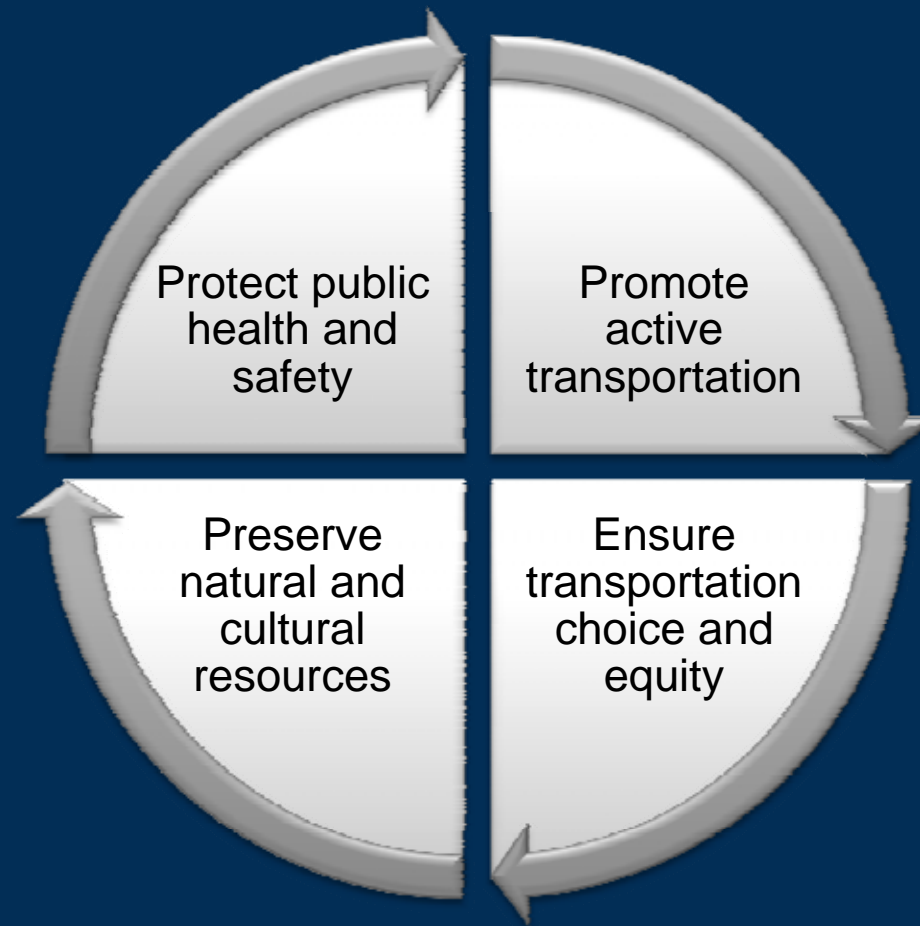

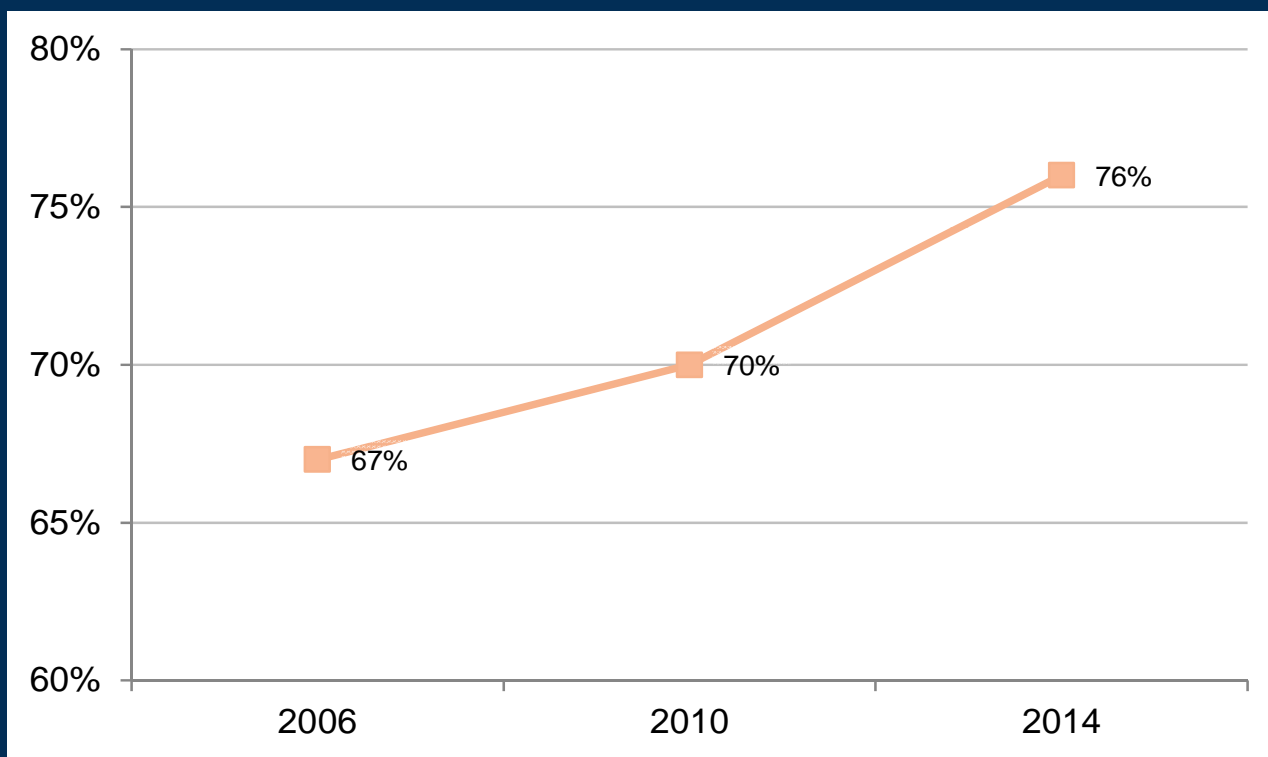

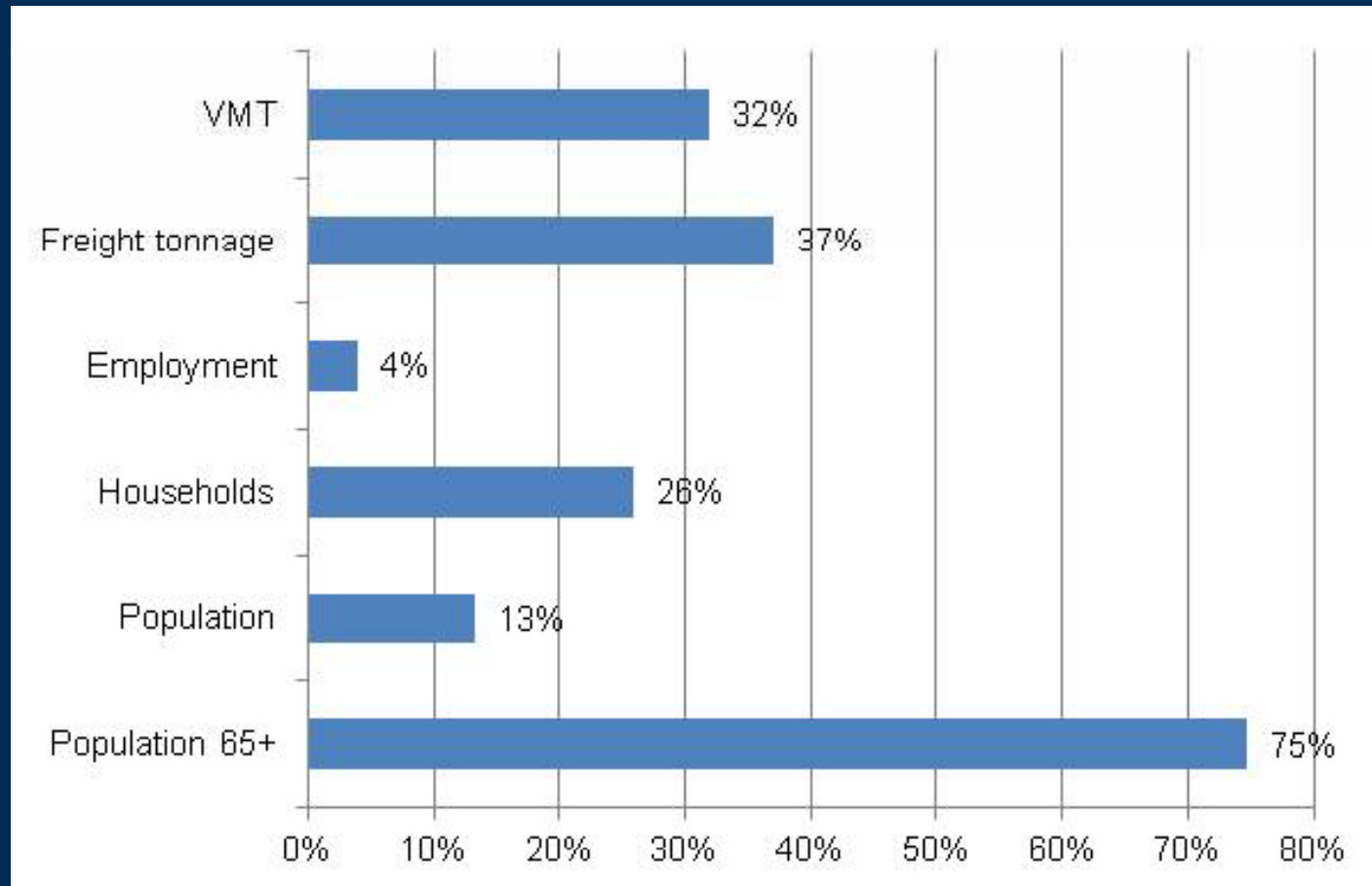
Travel Needs are Met “Well” or “Very Well”*

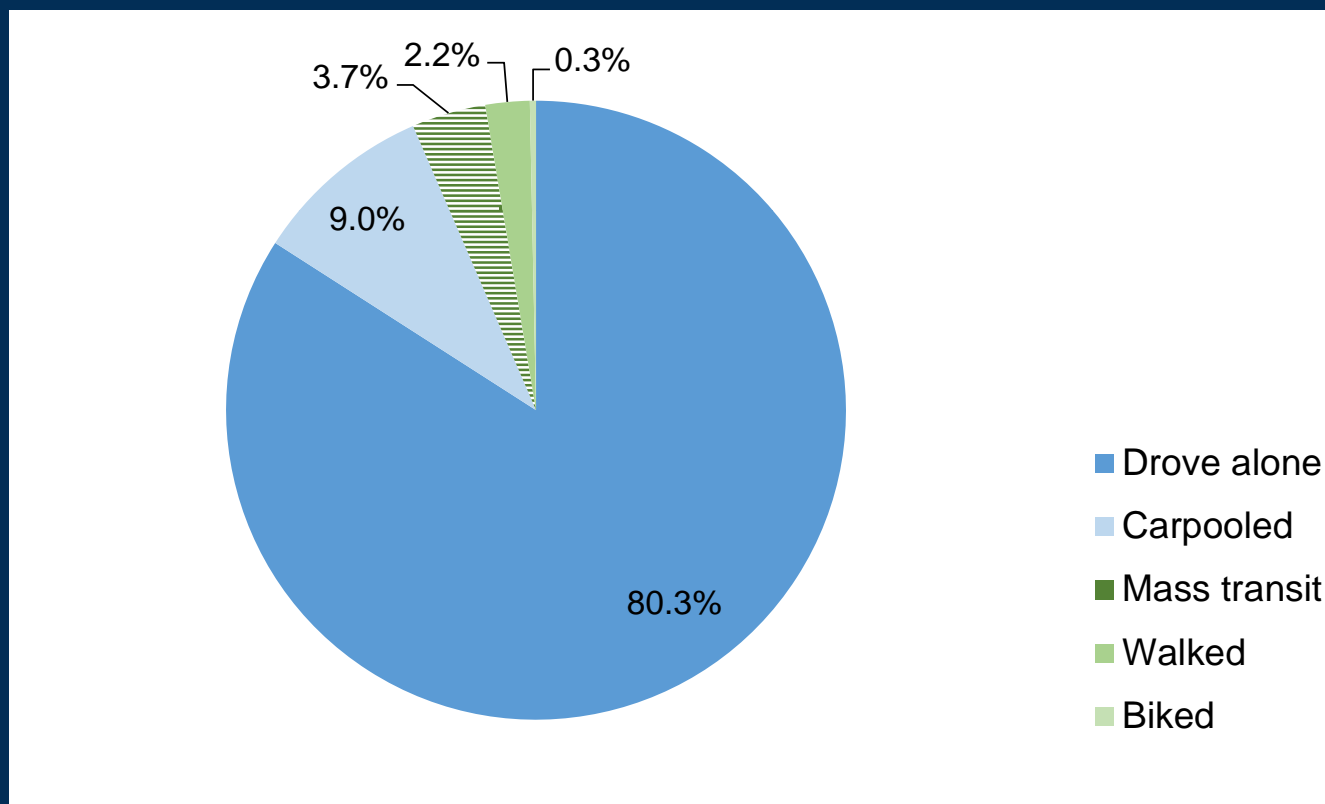
Forecasted Regional Changes through 2040*

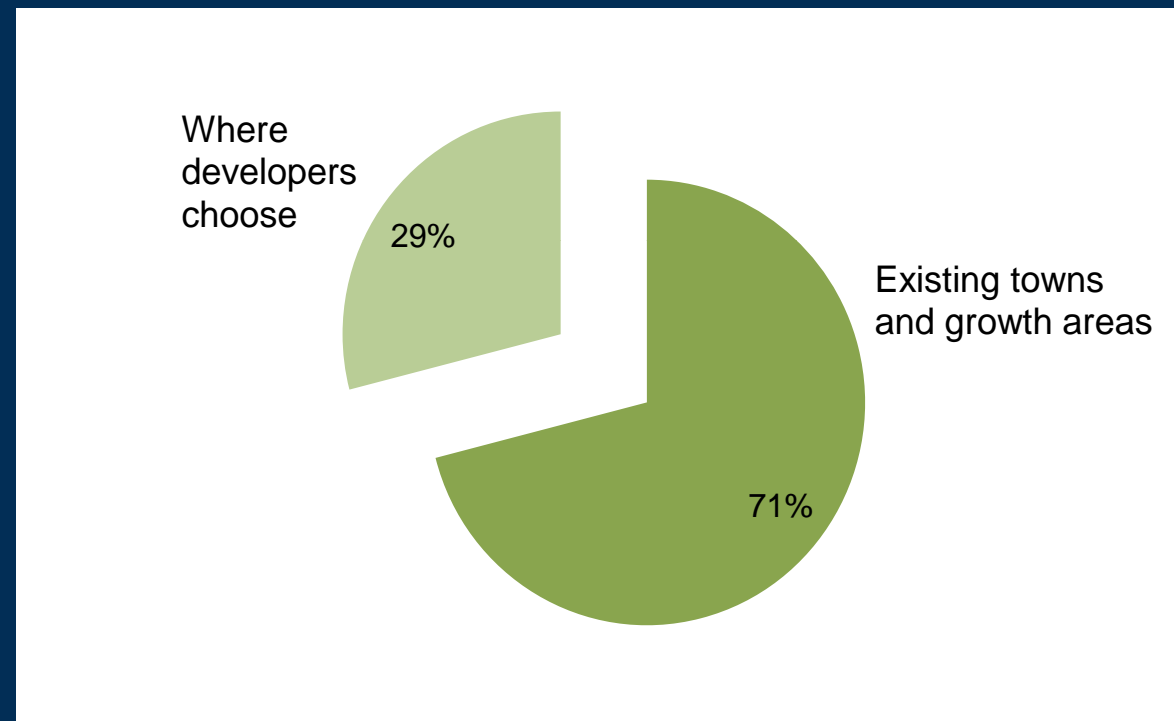

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Draft Amendments to FY 2015-18 TIP

- Four-year listing of priority transportation projects drawn from the RTP
- Includes all federal and state capital projects
- Amendments based on Delaware Bond Bill
- Council adoption expected this month



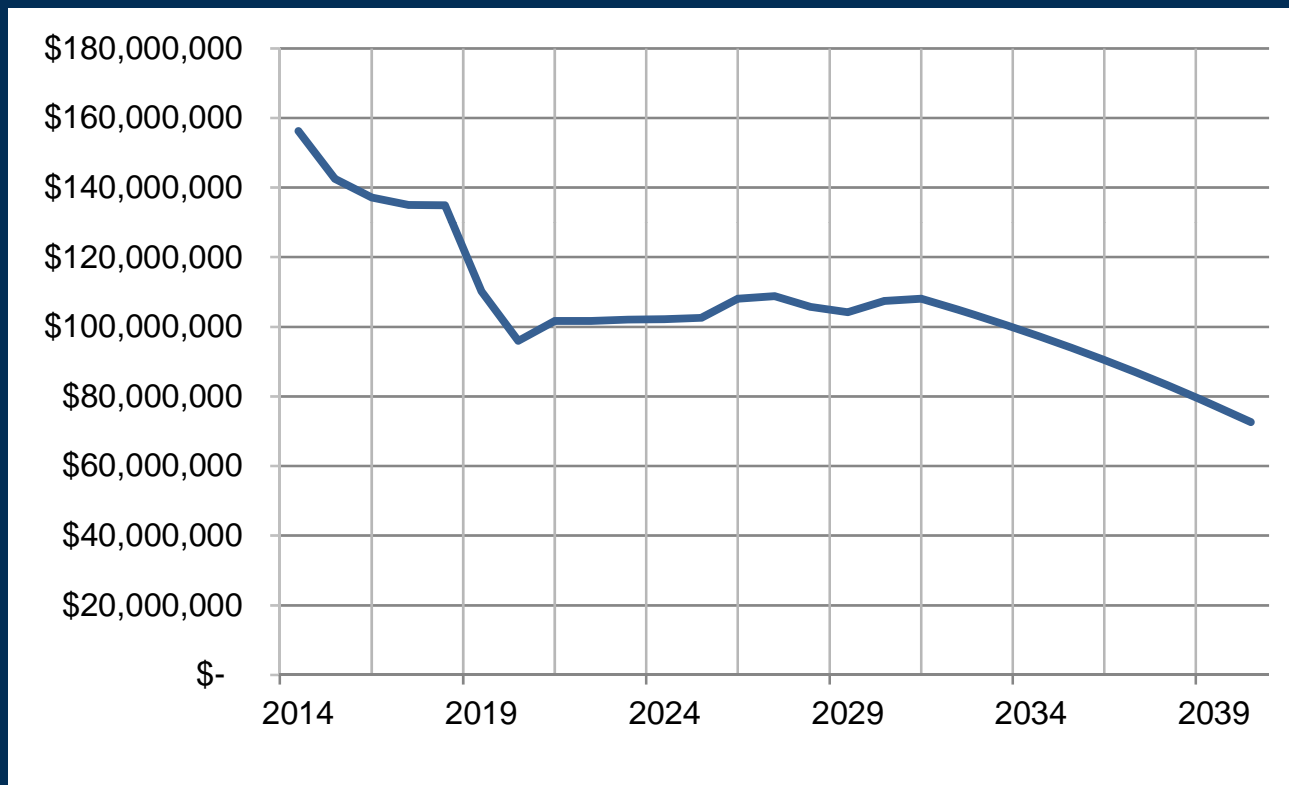
Draft Amendments to FY 2015-18 TIP

- \$1.7 billion in road, transit, rail, multimodal & bicycle/pedestrian projects
- 6% less funding than the TIP approved in March 2014
- Eliminates all funds from 11 projects, including:
 - Tyler McConnell Bridge
 - Wilmington Transit Hub
- Eliminates construction funds from 12 projects, including:
 - Christina River Bridge
 - Claymont and Newark Train Stations
- Adds 2 bridge projects:
 - BR 185 on Oak Ridge Road over Hyde Run
 - BR 813 on I-495 over Christina River, Emergency Repairs

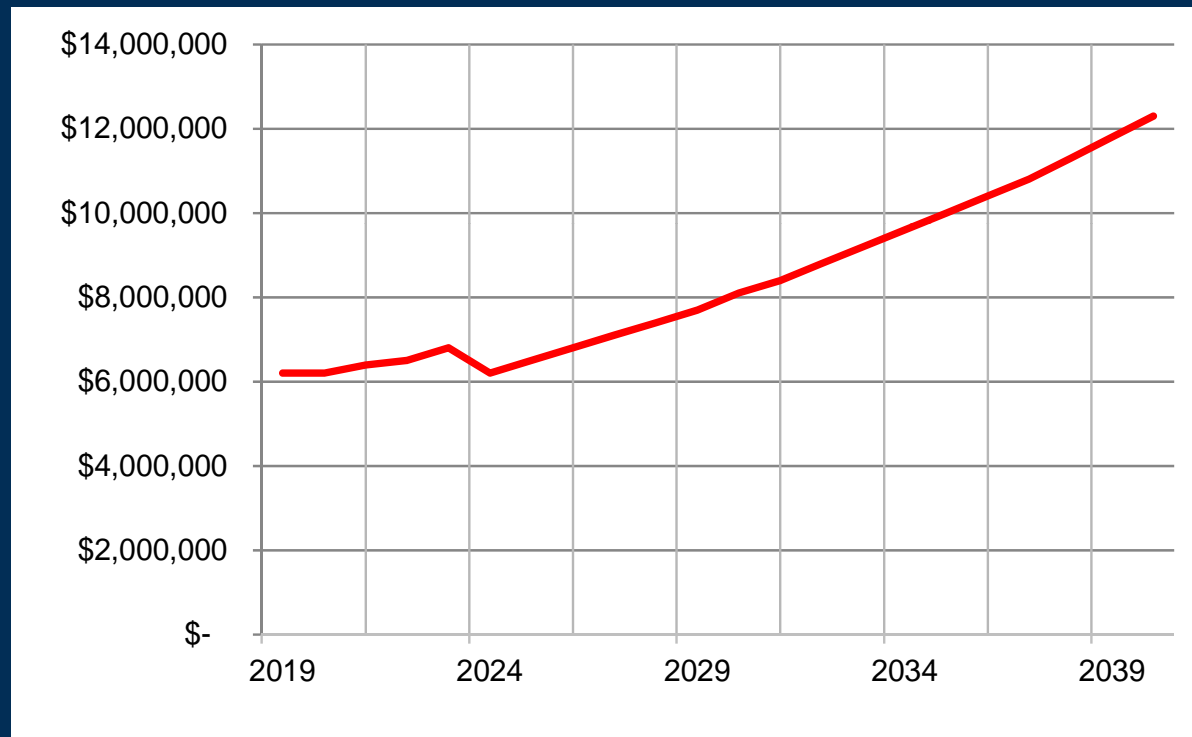
Funding Forecast for Capital Improvements, New Castle County*

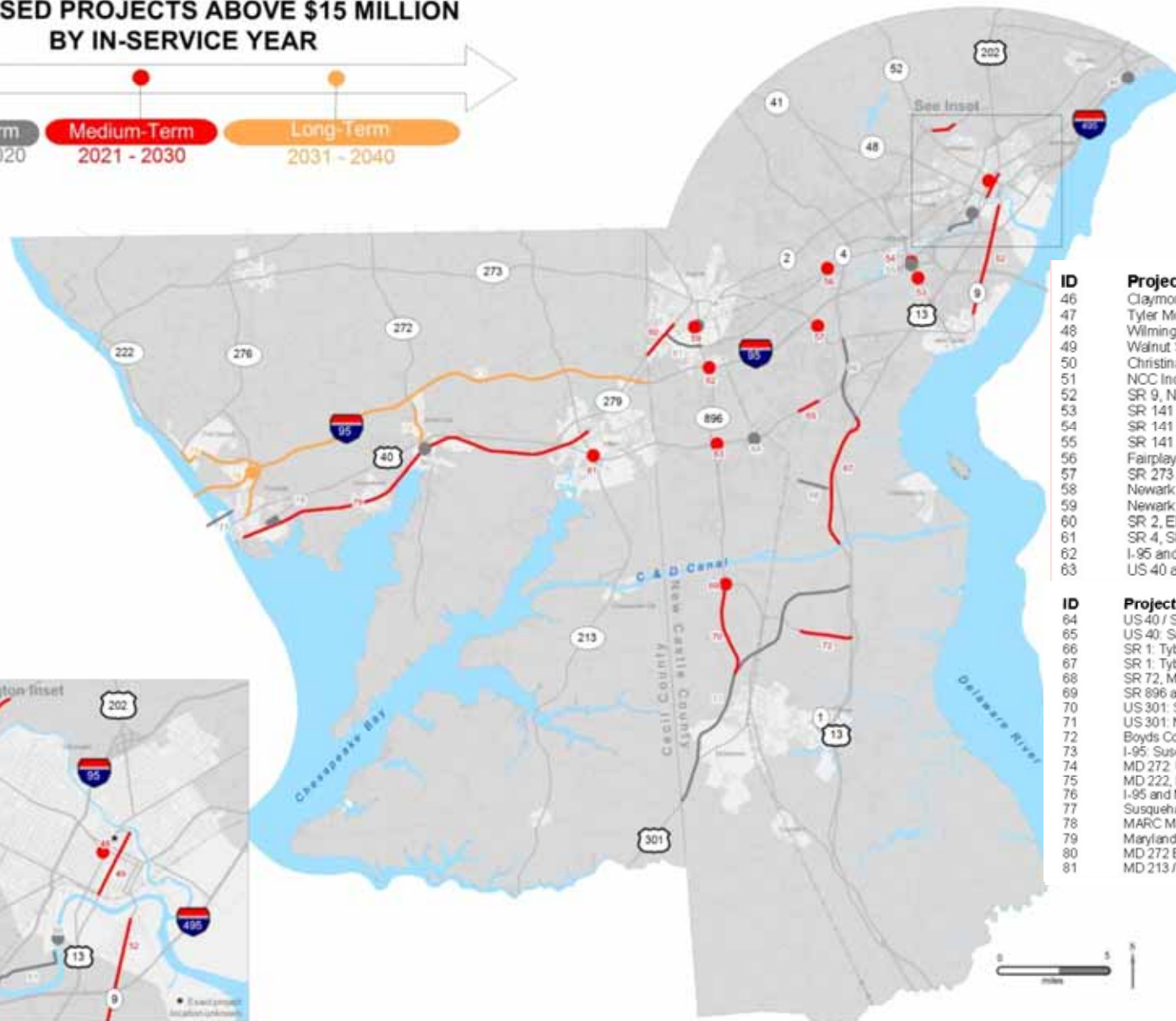
Funding Forecast for Capital Improvements, Cecil County*
