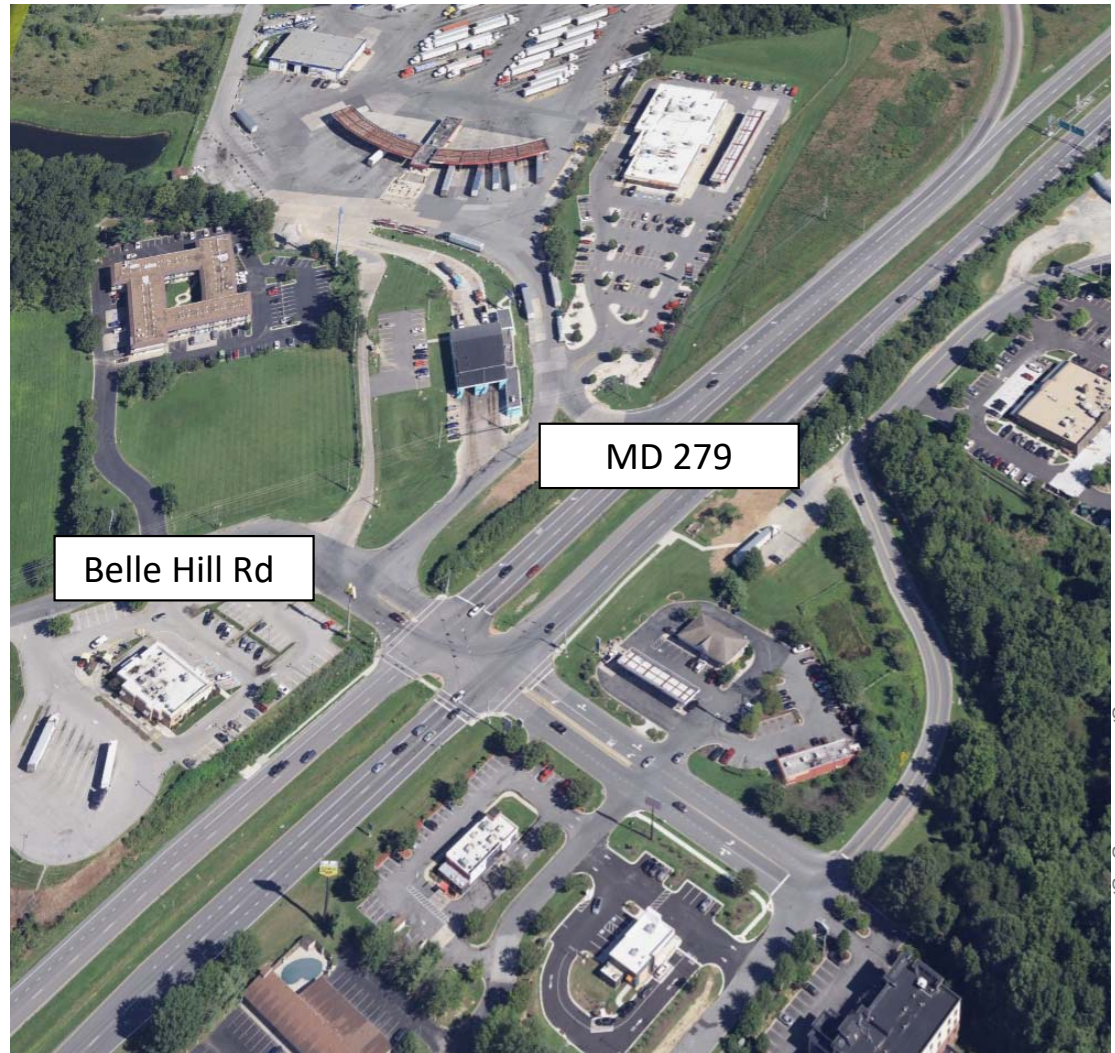
East Elkton Plan Zoning

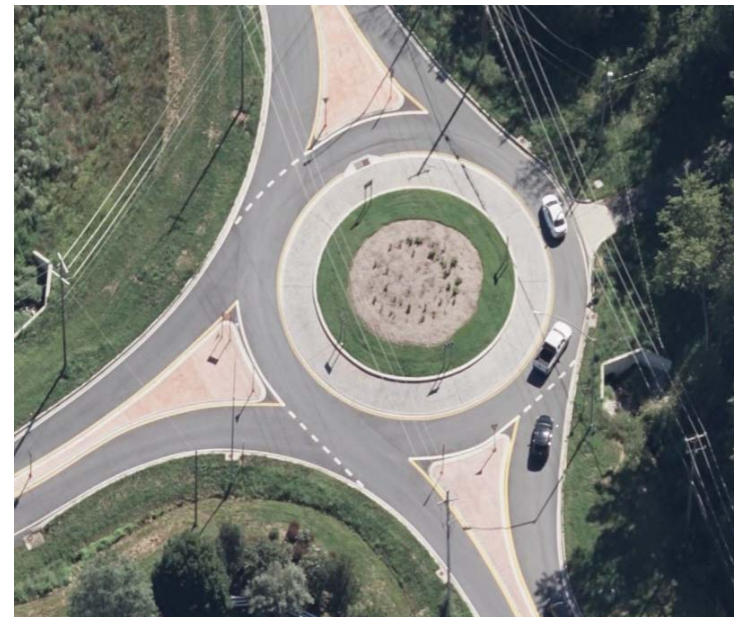
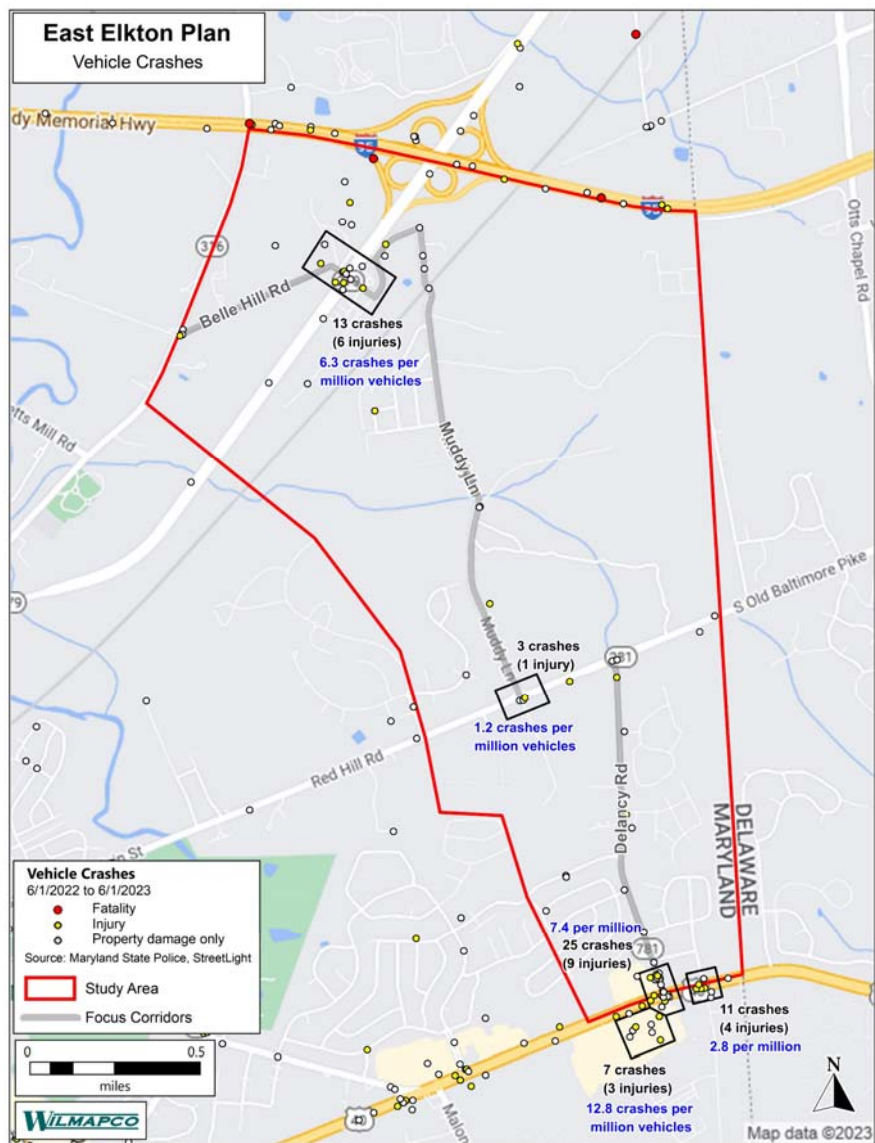

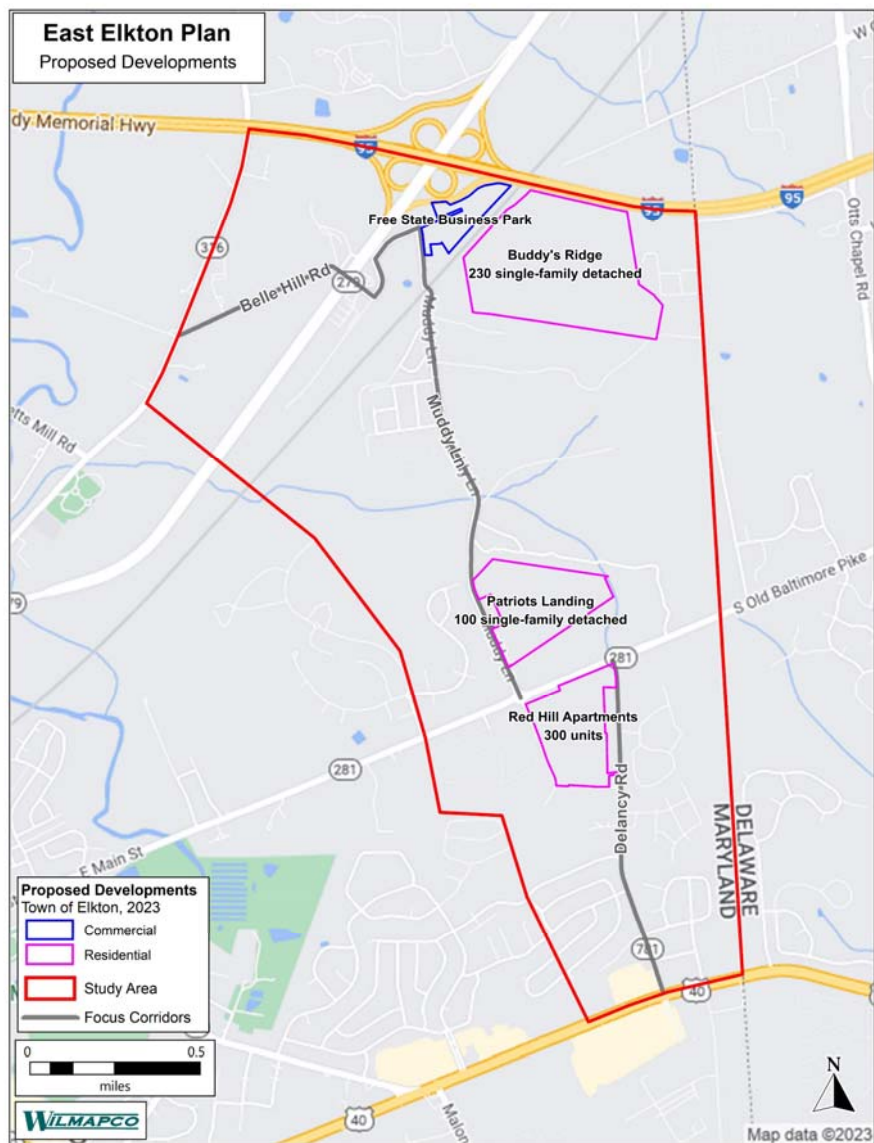

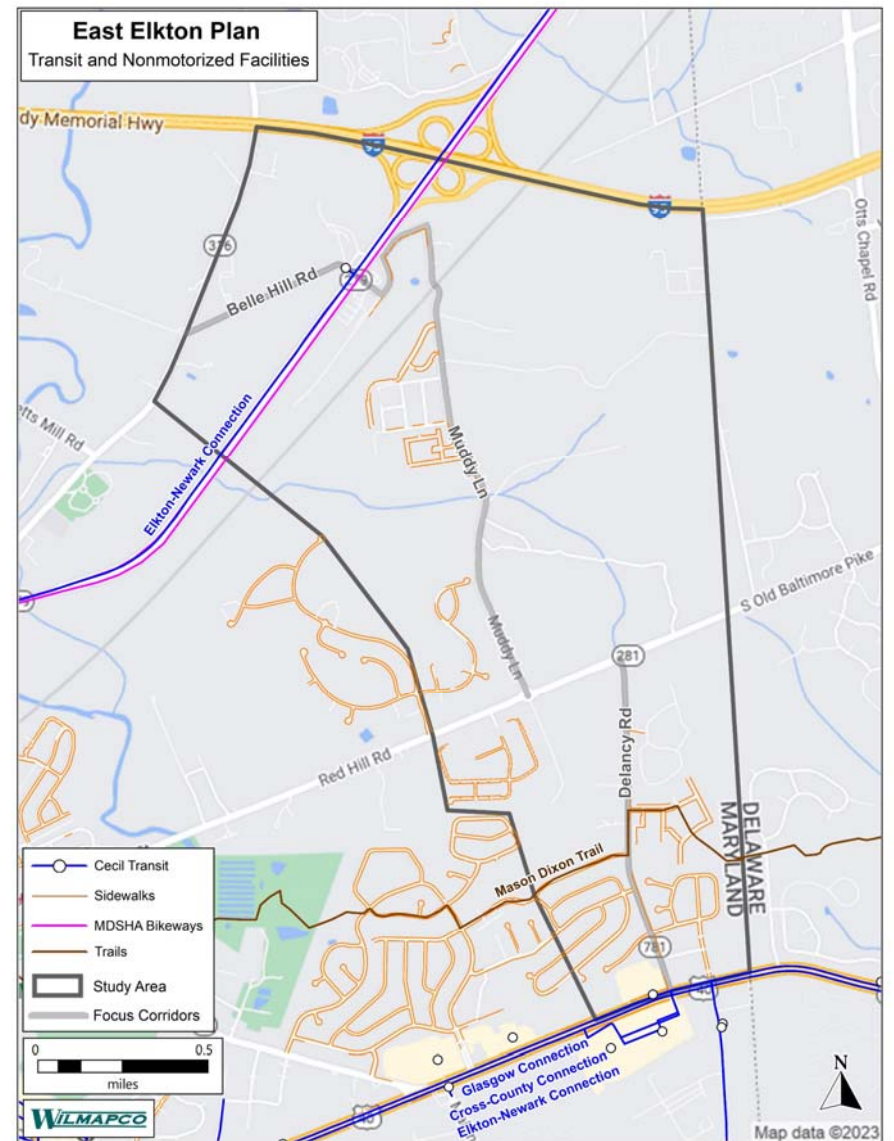
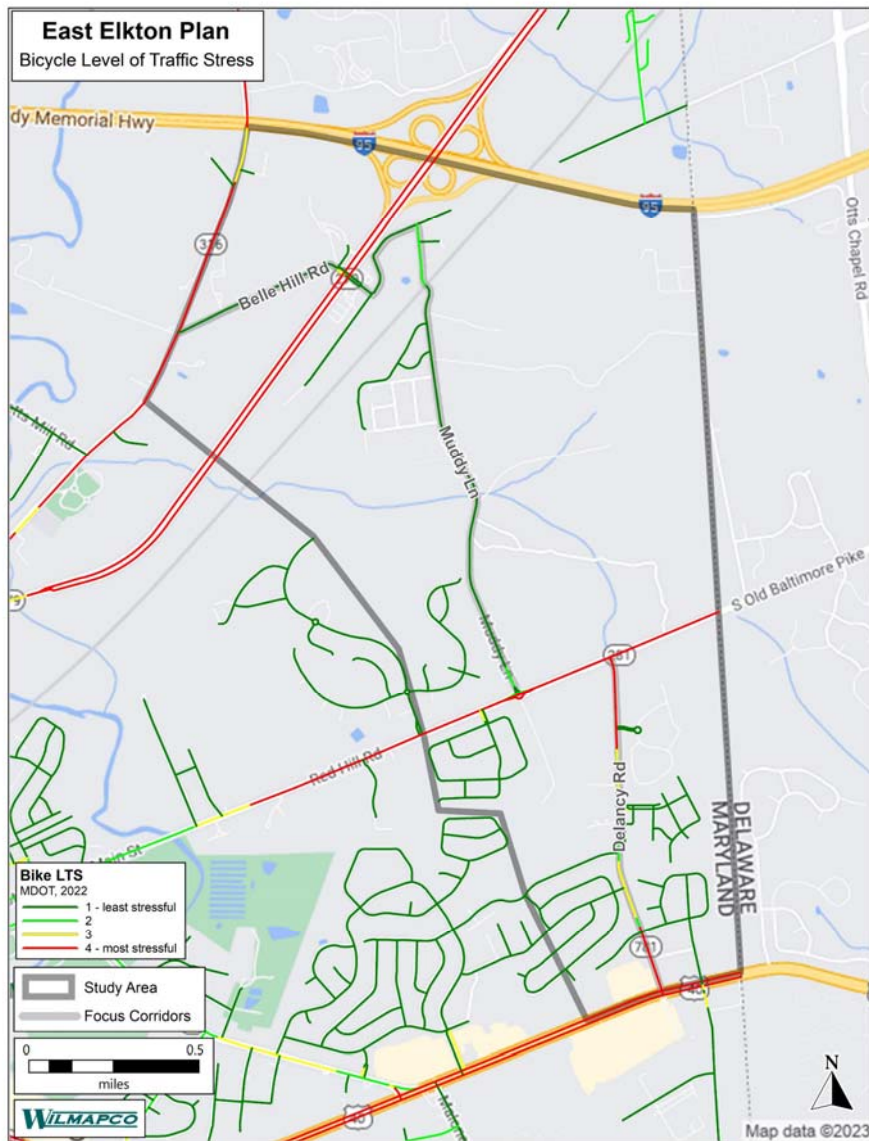


Cecil County Comprehensive Plan, 2010
