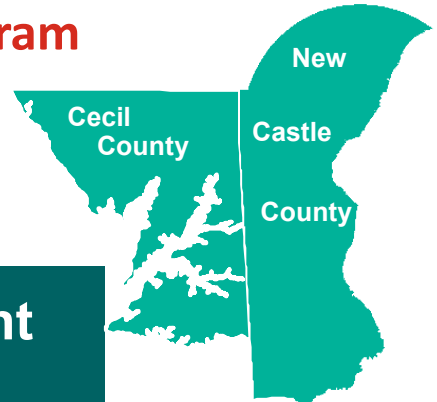


HAVE A SAY IN HOW YOUR TAX DOLLAR\$ ARE SPENT

Draft TIP is available for public comment through September 6, 2016

Draft TIP Includes

- \$2.3 billion in road, transit, rail, multimodal, bicycle, and pedestrian projects
- 6 percent more funding than the previously approved TIP
- Projects removed or changed due to lack of funding:
 - ⇒ Grubb Road Pedestrian Improvements
 - ⇒ US 13, Claymont Plan Implementation - No future phases are currently planned

New projects in the Draft TIP

- Bridge preservation for:
 - ⇒ BR 294 on Walther Road over Tributary to Christina River
 - ⇒ BR 302 over Toms Creek and BR 304 over Gambles Gut on SR 9
 - ⇒ BR 501 on SR 141 Newport Viaduct over Christina River
- Extension of I-495 Lane at I-95, southbound
- Stabilize slope on Mill Creek Road from Stella Road to Nathalie Drive
- Commuter rail station compatibility with the new SEPTA Key Card payment technology
