We are requesting an Administrative Modification to our FY 2021 - 2024 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), for the project, Rehabilitation of I-95, from Wilmington Viaduct to North of Brandywine River Bridge (T201407404), which can be found on page 284 of the Capital Transportation Program. The Construction estimate has increased \$678,558 on T201907002 due to additional funds needed for revisions and additions to the project. The increased federal obligation will occur in FY2021.
