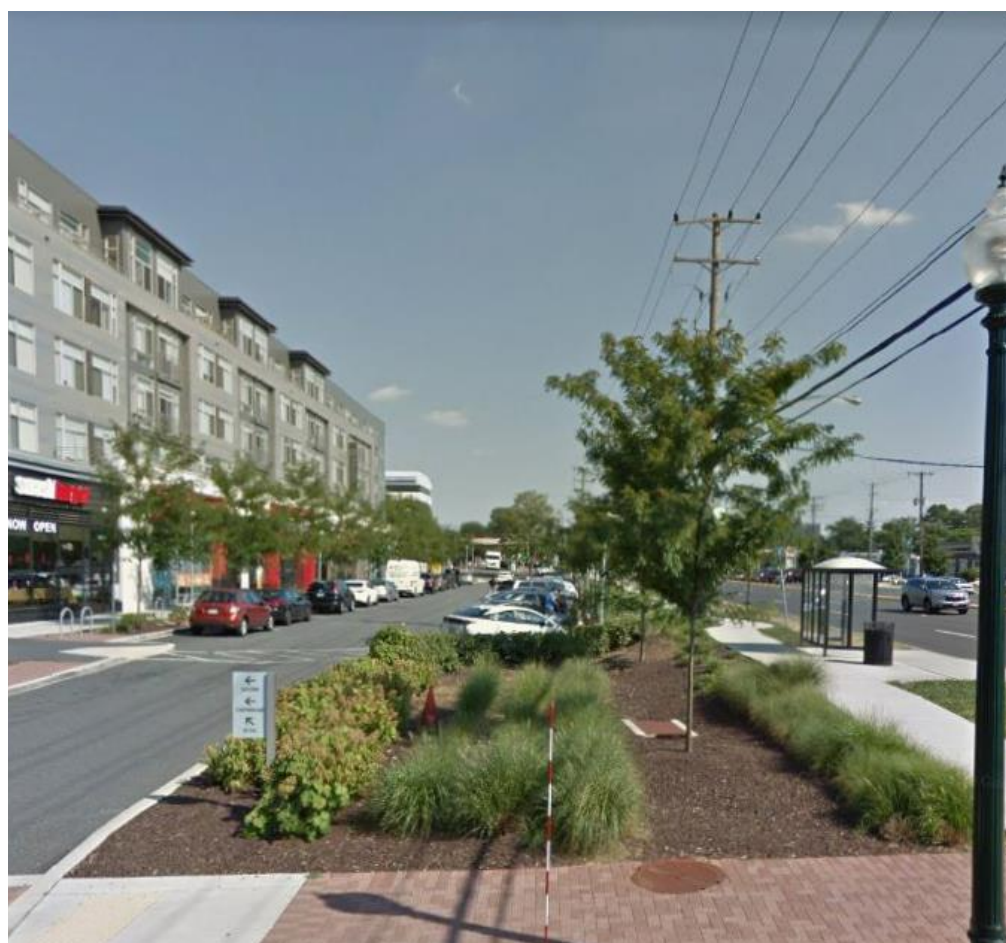
Multiway Overview

A multiway is a local road parallel to a higher volume, higher speed road. Multiways separate through traffic from local traffic, improve shared access, and connect retail destinations. Landscaping, parking, and sidewalks often separate multiways from the main roadway. These elements help to calm traffic and create a neighborhood feel on the outside edge of the multiway.

A multiways configuration would improve shared access to businesses and reduce conflict points along Concord Pike. To access most retail on Concord Pike, vehicles must slow down significantly to make a safe turn into a driveway, and drivers following this vehicle must respond quickly. Sudden turns off this high-speed road can also endanger those walking on the sidewalk, especially when the sidewalk is often disrupted by driveways. Multiways reduce these opportunities for conflicts by providing a roadway for slower moving local traffic.

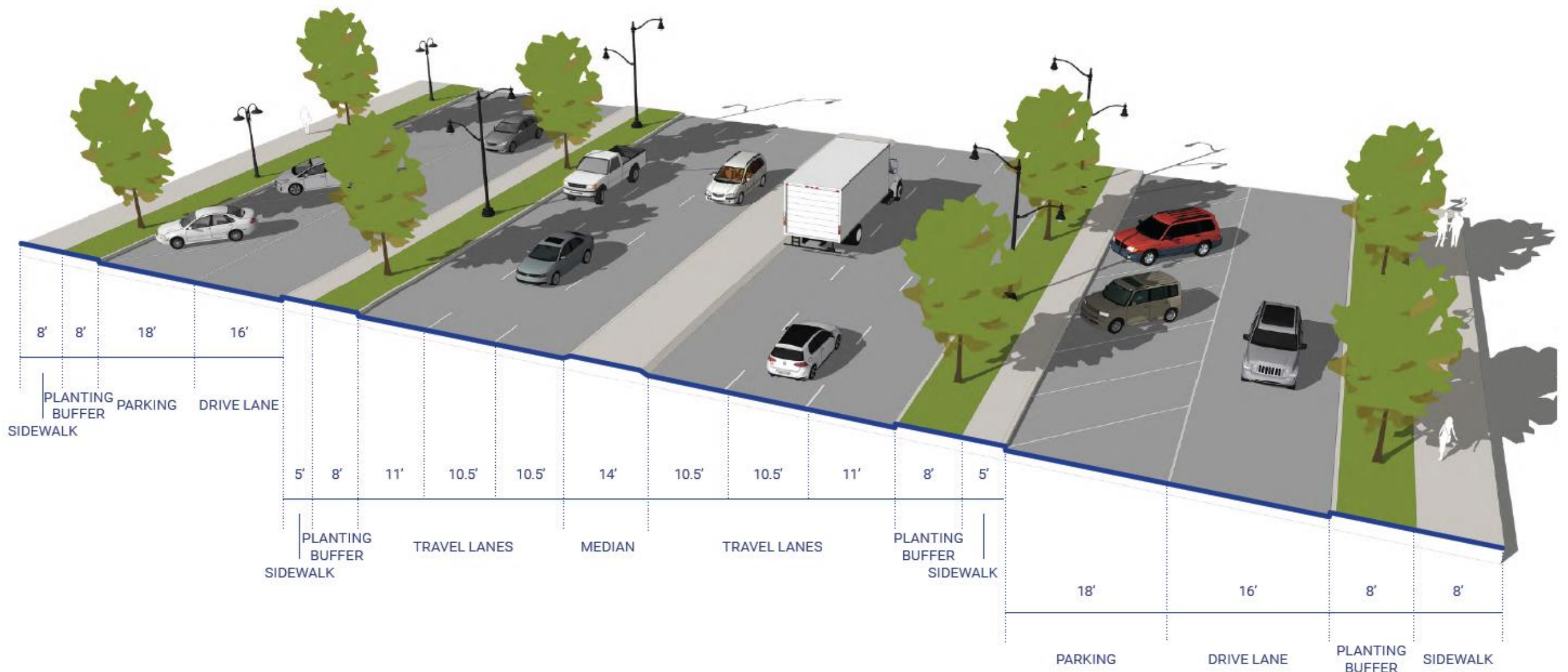
In addition, multiways improve access to local businesses by connecting smaller developments. Some retail destinations near Concord Mall and in Fairfax Shopping Center have connected parking lots, but many others are disconnected. The separate parking lots require drivers to exit onto Concord Pike to access a neighboring building. Multiways with sidewalks help connect nearby destinations for people in cars and on foot.

Limited to one travel lane and one parking lane, multiways can provide a less intimidating environment for pedestrians and bicyclists. While the total crossing distance from one side of Concord Pike to the other remains long, the multiway configuration helps break the crossing into multiple stages.

Conceptual Street Network – Multiway #1



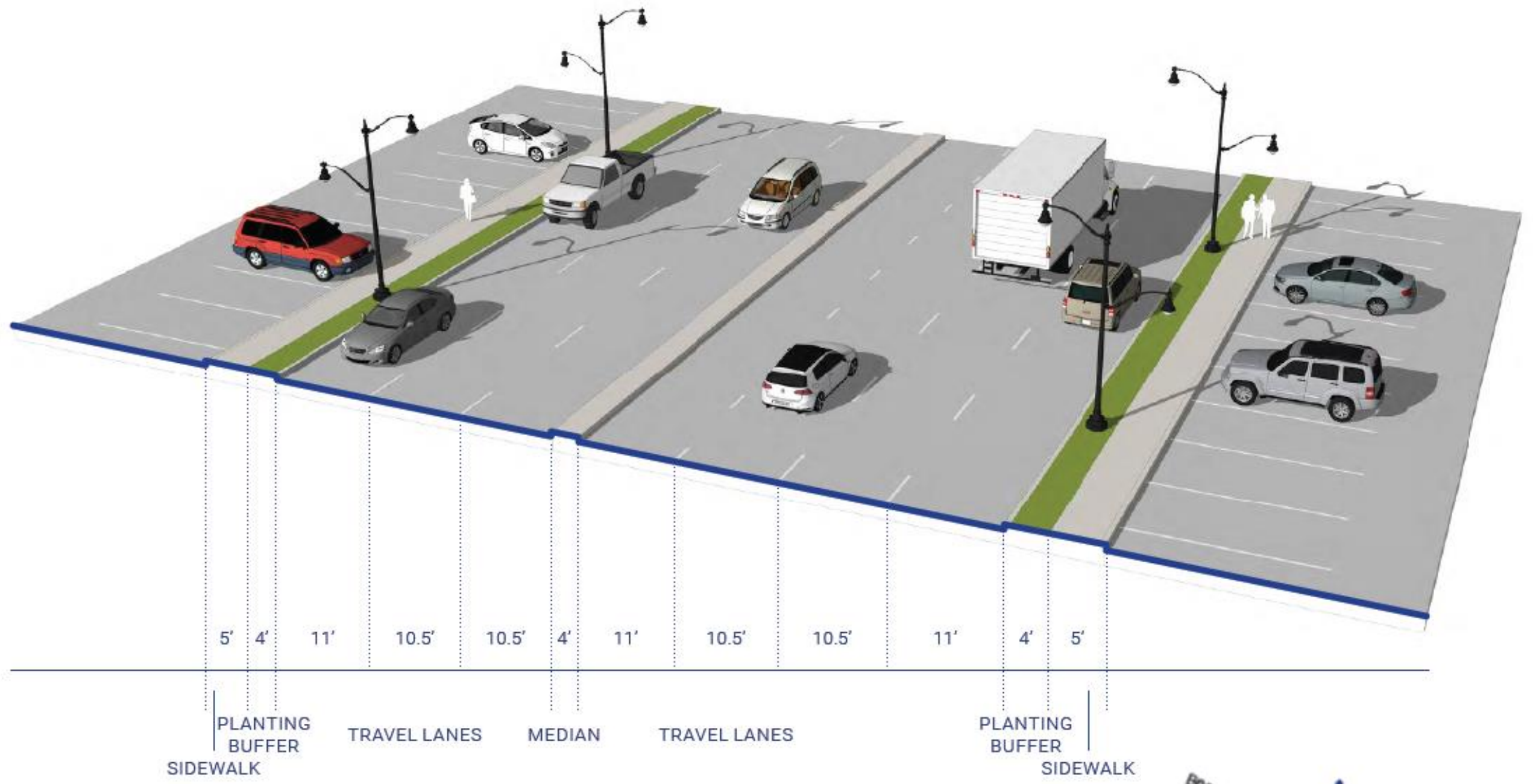
NOTE: ANGLED PARKING MAY BE EITHER HEAD-IN OR REVERSE-ANGLE

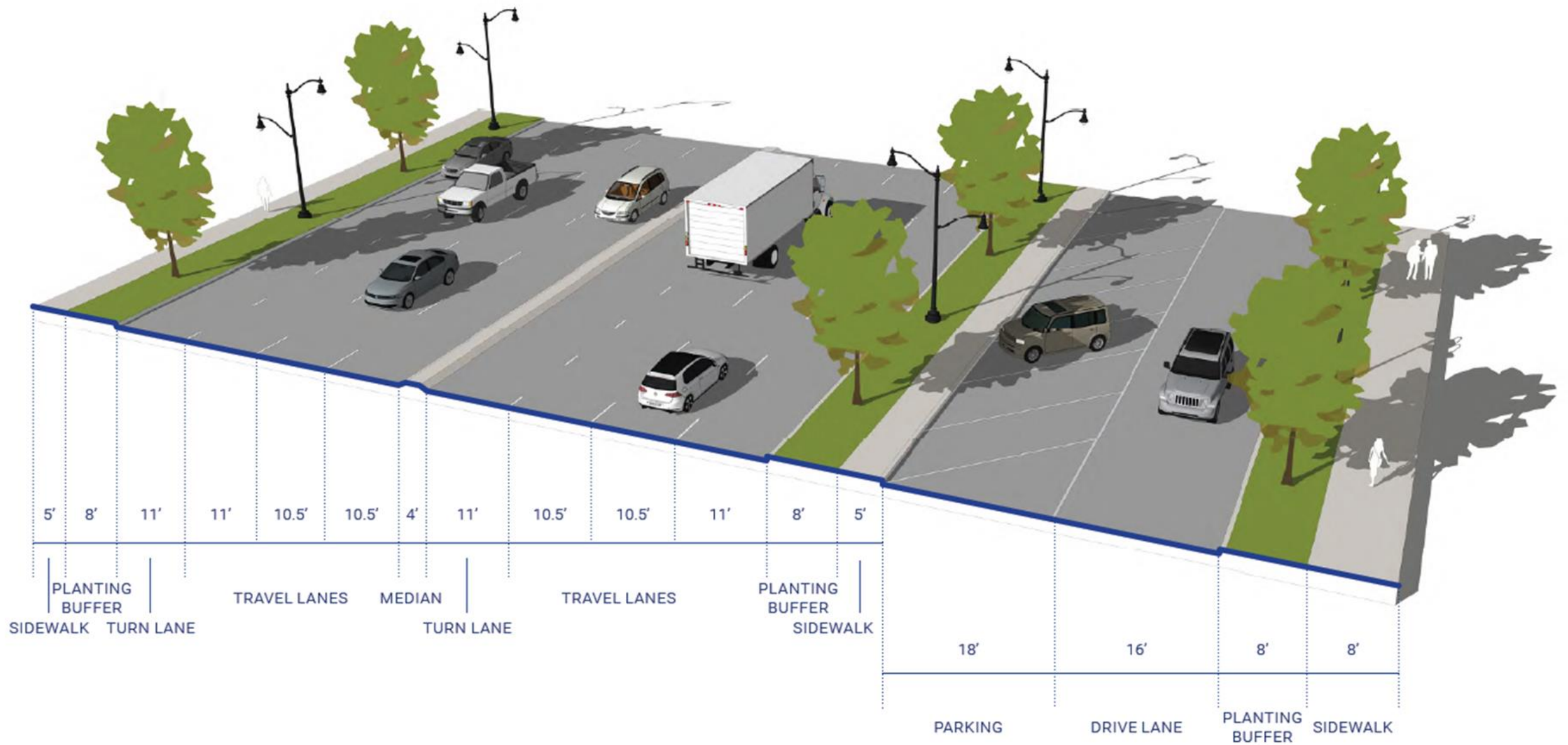
Conceptual Street Network – Multiway #2



CONCORD PIKE From Florence Avenue to Fairfax Boulevard



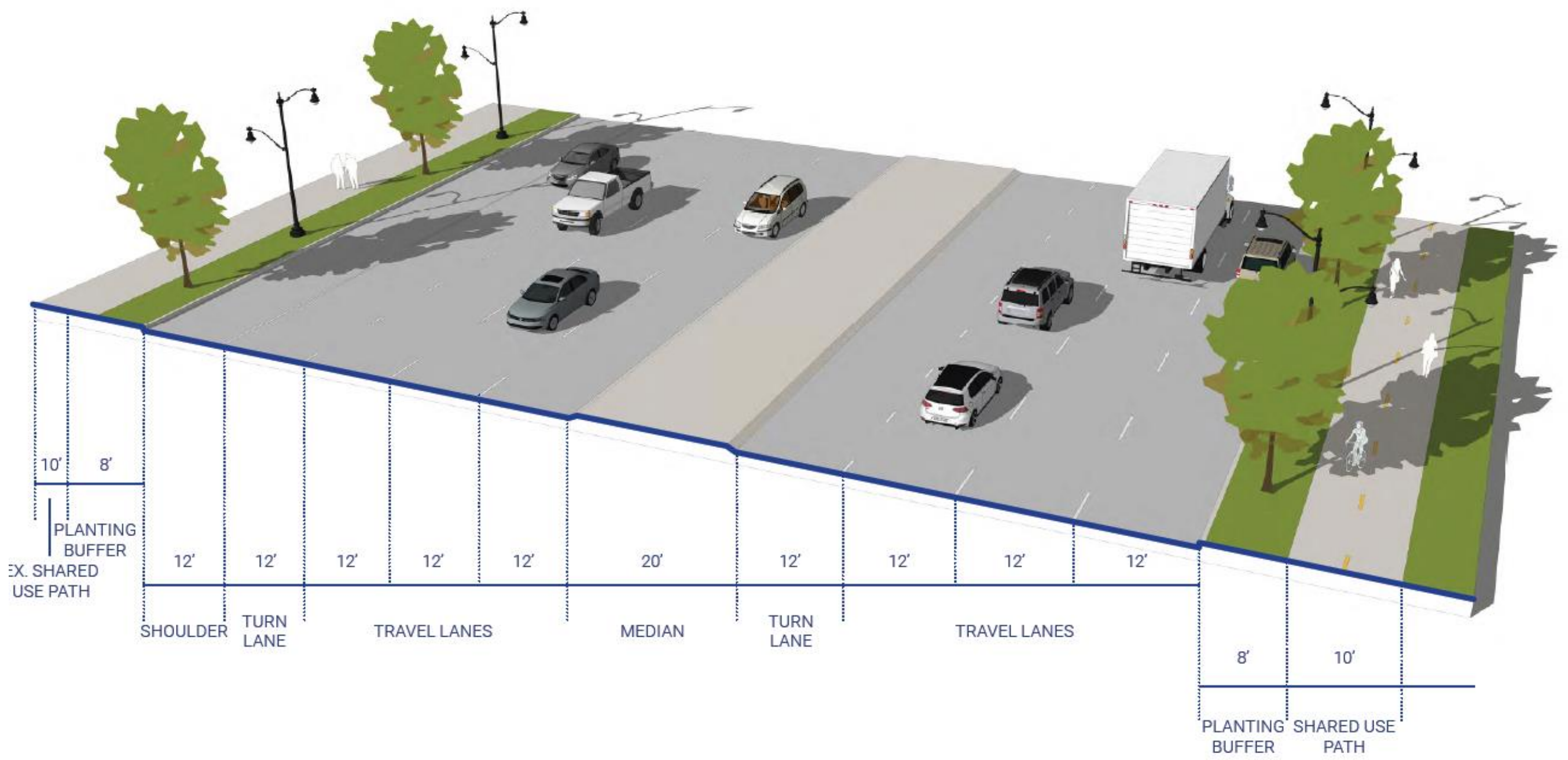
Conceptual Street Network – Multiway #3
