Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendments

The New Castle County and Delaware statewide portions of the TIP are amended each year to reflect funding available in the Delaware Bond Bill. This year, the TIP will see a 25% increase in funding. Funds will be spent on projects that preserve the existing infrastructure, address safety, and have public support.

Eleven new projects are being proposed for implementation, including:

- SR 72/SR 1 Diverging Diamond Interchange
- Tweeds Mill Parking Structure Repairs
- Claymont Train Station
- Fairplay Station Churchman's Crossing Parking Expansion
- I-95 & SR 896 Interchange Improvements
