




Median Spending by TIA vs. Future Projected Households: FY 2004 TIP to FY 2020 TIP


Mode of Transportation to Work, WILMAPCO Region














Pavement in Good Condition



Population Living Nearby Bus Stops










Percent of the Non-Interstate National Highway System Providing Reliable Travel Times




Total Non-motorized Injuries and Fatalities (NPM)

Median Trail Count, New Castle County







% of Bicycling Commutes


