Project Limits and Goals


The project will provide an 8-ft wide shared use path for bicyclists and pedestrians between S. Church St and S. Walnut Street, to connect to the existing shared use path over the Senator Margaret Rose Henry Bridge.

Project Concepts

- Shared Use Path includes boardwalk to span wetlands, and “stone” dust and/or concrete surface in other locations
- Alternatives to connect to S. Walnut under consideration
- Possible connection to Chase Fieldhouse also under consideration
- Will be open from dawn to dusk, consistent with South Wilmington Wetland Park and other parks in the City
