MDOT MTA is requesting an administrative modification to the FY 2021-2024 WILMAPCO TIP for Small Urban Transit System - Capital and Operating Assistance page, TIP ID # MTA LINE 52.

MDOT MTA is decreasing Section 5310 federal funding for capital assistance by \$19K in FY 2022. This difference in funding is based on anticipated versus actual awards. This source of funding will be used to provide capital assistance for one minivan and one small bus. For the FY 2022 round of awards to the non-profit organizations, FTA is not requiring a local match.

The proposed action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current TIP, which continues to be fiscally constrained.
