Action Item #13 : To Endorse the Five Point Intersection Safety & Capacity Improvement Study

Description/Summary of Item: Staff will present the recommendations from the Five Point Intersection Safety & Capacity Improvement Study. The goal of the project is to recommend roadway and infrastructure improvements to address operational and safety issues in the vicinity of the 5 Point intersection of Maryland Avenue, S. Madison Street, and Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.

Summary of Action Taken by PAC: The public outreach process was presented to the PAC on December 14, 2020; no action was taken.

Summary of Action Taken by TAC:

This project was presented to the TAC on April 18, 2019, March 19, 2020 and November 19, 2020. The TAC recommended endorsing the Five Point Intersection Safety & Capacity Improvement Study at their December 17, 2020 meeting.

Summary of Action Taken by Subcommittee/Task Force (if applicable):

The Wilmington Initiatives Partners served as the Project Management Committee (PMC) for this study beginning with a Kick-off on May 15, 2018. The PMC endorsed the recommendations from the Five Point Intersection Safety & Capacity Improvement Study at their December 17, 2020 meeting.
